



## Alexander O. Passano

February 6, 1943 - May 25, 2019

Alexander O. Passano, of Sterling, VA, passed away on May 25, 2019 at the age of 76, after a long struggle with cancer. He was born in Panama and at the age of 2, relocated to New York City with his family. A few years later, they moved to Long Island where Alexander lived for over 50 years until his most recent relocation to Northern Virginia.

Alexander earned a Bachelor's degree in Chemistry from St. Johns University and a Masters degree in Forensic Science from John Jay College of Criminal Justice. In 1966, he joined the NYC Police Department as a Patrolman and eventually rose to the rank of Lieutenant. Throughout his time on the force, he spent many years working in the Crime Lab. After his retirement, he started a small painting business which he ran for several years.

Alexander was an avid bowler, often participating in multiple leagues at the same time. He was an active member of his church, where he sang in the choir and assisted with numerous fundraising activities. A steadfast volunteer with the Knights of Columbus Council 7278 Mother Cabrini, he took on multiple leadership roles and built strong friendships within the brotherhood.

His parents, Elena Isabel Garrido and Alfred O. Passano preceded him in death. He is survived by his three children James, Jeanne and Danielle; son-in-law Jade; granddaughter Taylor; brother Alfred and wife Jill; sister Betty Passaro; and 7 nieces and nephews.
