Juanita Sue (Sibold) Rorrer, 80, of Haymarket, VA passed peacefully at her home surrounded by her family on October 27th, 2019.

Juanita was born November 17, 1938 in Covington, VA. The daughter of the late John Otis Sibold and Sue (Adams) Sibold. She was a 1954 graduate of Covington High School.
