December 20, 1914 - September 5, 2014

Helen Conley went home to be with the Lord on Friday, September 5, 2014 at the age of 99. At the time of her death she was a resident of Birmingham Green Nursing Home in Manassas, VA having moved there in October, 2006.

Helen was born December 20, 1914 in Wirt County, West Virginia to Ulysses and Ethel Givens. She told the story of the cold and wintery day of her birth when the doctor (intoxicated) had to ride the horse to the family home in the country. She worked in manufacturing jobs doing piece work in Parkersburg, West Virginia and Akron, Ohio for many years before marrying Roy Conley in June, 1952 and moving to Pughtown, West Virginia. The family moved to Fairfax County, Virginia in 1965. She was a member of Bethlehem Baptist Church (now Fair Oaks Church) in Fairfax, and later in her life Temple Baptist in Herndon. The most important thing in her life was knowing Christ as her Savior, having accepted Him at the age of 16 in a boarding school in Colcord, West Virginia.

Helen is survived by a son and a daughter as well as 2 stepsons, and 6 grandchildren. She is predeceased by Roy in January, 1981 as well as her 3 siblings.

The funeral service will be held at Pierce Funeral Home, 9609 Center St., Manassas, Virginia on Wednesday, September 10, 2014 at 11:00 AM with

visiting one hour prior. Interment will follow at Fairfax Memorial Park, Fairfax, Virginia.
