April 18, 1917 - January 2, 2011

Alice E. Shurtleff, 93, beloved mother, grandmother, and great grandmother died Sunday 2 January 2011 in Palm Coast, Flagler, Florida of heart failure. Mrs. Alice E Shurtleff, widow of Miller Francis Shurtleff, had lived in Northern Virginia for more than 50 years before moving to Florida about 5 years ago. She was born in Atlanta, Georgia April 18, 1917, daughter of William H and Ina J. Hawkins. She married Miller F. Shurtleff in 1941 in Atlanta, but they soon made their home in the Washington D.C. area where her husband worked in the government for his entire career.
