Allen Richard Dewey, age 77 of Gainesville, VA died on Wednesday, January 1, 2014 at Heathcote Health Care Center.

He was preceded in death by his son Richard Allen Dewey.

He was in the Air Force from 1954-1957 and then went to work for the C.I.A. retiring in 1986. After his retirement from the CIA he then worked for TRW, Northrop Grumman and EIS retiring again in 2006. He traveled extensively overseas and domestically his entire working career of almost 50 years.

Survivors include his loving wife of 55 years, Nancy F. Dewey; his daughter Patricia Dewey and his brother William Dean Dewey.

Funeral services will be held at Pierce Funeral Home, 9609 Center Street, Manassas, VA on Thursday, January 9, 2014 at 1:00 PM with Rev. Billy Tatum officiating. Interment will take place at Quantico National Cemetery. The family will receive friends from noon until service time.
