ANGELA G. GREGORY, age 81 of Manassas, Virginia passed away Tuesday, April 3, 2007 at Prince William Hospital, Manassas.

Angela was born August 27, 1925 in Fayette County, Pennsylvania daughter of the late Joseph and Pearl Belch Glumsic. She graduated from Temple Business School in Washington, D.C. and was employed with the FBI. Angela and John O. Gregory were married on June 6, 1948. She was a resident of Manassas and a lifelong member of Bethel Evangelical Lutheran Church. Angela played an active role in many organizations in the Manassas community. Angela was the founder and the first president of the Prince William Hospital Ladies Auxiliary. She was a member and also President of the Junior Women's Club and the Woman's Club of Manassas, where many scholarships were awarded in the community, as well as President of the Virginia Federation of Women's Clubs. Angela was an active member of the Bull Run Republican Women's Club and the City of Manassas Republican Committee and was a voting delegate to the Republican National Conventions. Angela was honored to be named "Woman of the Year" by the City of Manassas in 2001 and rode as Grand Marshal in the Annual Christmas Parade. Her outstanding service and dedication has left a lasting legacy to this community. Angela was a loving and dedicated wife, mother and grandmother.

She is preceded in death by her son, John Scott Gregory, Sr.

Survivors include her loving husband of 59 years, John O. Gregory; two sisters, Mildred Jones of Masontown, Pennsylvania and Melva Salopek of Ft. Lauderdale, Florida; one brother, Fred Glumsic of Masontown, Pennsylvania and three grandchildren, Taylor Grace, Jessica Angela and John Scott Gregory, Jr. all of Manassas.
