March 25, 1923 - March 31, 2010

ANN H HADJY, age 87, formerly of Hyattsville, Maryland, died Wednesday March 31, 2010, at Prince William Hospital in Manassas, Virginia.

Ann was born March 25, 1923, in Nicosia, Cyprus, and is the daughter of the late Melani Melithoni and Panayiotou Scordi.
