July 24, 1918 - March 2, 2017

Ann W. Vliet, formerly of McLean, VA went to be with the Lord on Thursday, March 2, 2017.

She was born in Mentone, IN on July 24, 1918 and spent her childhood there. She studied piano and Bible at Moody Bible Institute and Wheaton College in Illinois. She joined the WAVES in WWII and was stationed in San Francisco. She returned to Chicago after the war and married Charles Walker in 1948. Mr. Walker died in 1958.

In 1961, she moved with her daughter to Arlington, VA to teach piano. She became an active member of First Baptist Church of Clarendon, teaching Sunday school and playing the piano. She served as the pastor's secretary from 1968-1978.

In 1978 she married Arthur Vliet, retired, but continued to serve at FBC Clarendon as a teacher and pianist. The Vliets lived briefly in Arlington, then moved to Fairfax, where they lived for 22 years. Mrs. Vliet enjoyed reading, gardening, caring for her grandchildren, and taking horseback riding lessons. In 2001, the Vliets moved to Vinson Hall in McLean, where Mrs. Vliet participated in Bible studies, book clubs, and gave an occasional piano recital. Mrs. Vliet remained at Vinson Hall after her husband's death in 2005, until she relocated to Arbor Terrace Sudley Manor in Manassas in 2014.

Survivors include one sister, Ruth Gustafson, of Norcross, GA; one daughter, Pamela Green, of Centreville, VA; two stepsons: Alan Vliet & wife Susie of Falls Church, VA; Peter Vliet of McLean, VA; grandchildren: Ashley Vliet of Vienna, VA; Jeffrey Vliet of Vienna, VA; Joshua Green, wife Rebecca & children Josiah and Lilah of Zanesville, OH; Andrew Green, wife Lauren, & son Tristan of Forest Hill, MD; and numerous nieces & nephews.
