Arbutus Boots Childress, 77, passed away Monday, Oct. 30, 2006, at Annaburg Manor Nursing Home, Manassas, Va., where she had resided since 1969. Born Jan. 9, 1929, in Venia, Va., she was a daughter of the late John Bryan and Mary Belle (McGlothlin) Childress. She had lived in the Manassas area since 1941, when the family moved from Buchanan County, Va. She was of the Pentecostal faith.

Boots graduated from Osbourn High School, Manassas, in 1947 and began nurse's training. She was injured in a near-fatal car accident in 1952 that left her crippled. Even so, she maintained a positive outlook, had a wonderful sense of humor, and stayed interested in life. She had many visitors and friends, some from her high school days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by three sisters, Fayrene C. (James) Clayborn, Dian C. Blair (Juan Ayala), and Joan Sue Childress, and one brother, Benson Childress.
