Arlene Phyllis Boryschuk, 75, of Gainesville, Virginia, passed away on July 11, 2021. Arlene was born on June 1, 1946, to John and Anna May Dippel in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Arlene graduated from Olney High School, in Philadelphia, and went on to complete her nursing studies, on a full-paid Board of Education scholarship, at the Presbyterian Hospital School of Nursing, also in Philadelphia, graduating in June, 1966. On New Year's Eve of that same year, she married John, who was in the Air Force, and moved with him to Texas, Okinawa, and California, where her older son was born. After four years of military life, it was back to Pennsylvania, where her younger son was born. She spent 25 years in Pennsylvania, raising her children and preparing them for going solo, after which she moved, with John, to Virginia, where she spent the next 26 years enjoying her life as a Grandmother.

Arlene is survived by her husband, John Boryschuk; Children, Scott Boryschuk (Roxanne) and Christopher Boryschuk (Melissa); Grandchildren, Dusten, Michaela, Skyler, Hope, and Chase Boryschuk; and brother, John Dippel.

A memorial service will be held for Arlene on July 24th, 2021 at 10:00 AM at Pierce Funeral Home Chapel, 9609 Center Street, Manassas, Virginia 20110.
