Arnold Truman Davis, age 86 of Catlett, VA died on September 15, 2019 in Aldie, VA.

Arnold was born on November 6, 1932 in Elwood, Indiana to the late Albert and Opal (Hedemark) Davis.

Mr. Davis attended public schools in Anderson, Indiana, where he also attended College at the Anderson University before joining the Army. He was stationed in Germany and served in the 198th Infantry Battalion.
