



## Arthur Richard McAndrew Jr

December 15, 1921 - January 24, 2014

Retired Army Colonel Arthur Richard McAndrew of Manassas, VA, died peacefully in his home on Friday, January 24, 2014.

Born December 15, 1921, in Columbus, OH, he served in the US army as a Lieutenant during WWII participating in the campaign to liberate the Philippines from Japanese occupation and serving as a lead investigator of Japanese war crimes in the Philippines and China for the Army War Crimes Tribunal. He continued to serve in the US Army Reserves as an instructor for the Army Command and General Staff College retiring from the reserves in 1972 as a Colonel. He also served his country while working for the Department of Transportation for 29 years and retiring in 1982 as the Chief of the Operations Division of the Bureau of Motor Carrier Safety. After his federal service he continued to sell real estate for many years throughout the Prince William County area.

He is survived by his beloved wife, Patricia McAndrew, of 66 years. He was the loving father of Helen DeLozier of Dallas, TX; Patrick and Yvonne of Oklahoma City, OK; Richard and Paula of Pacifica, CA; Brian of Manassas, VA; Kathleen Ferguson and Paul Lumpkin of Culpepper, VA; Edward and Amanda of Mechanicsville, VA; David and Martina of Ophelia, VA. He was preceded in death by his son, Michael (married to Nancy McAndrew of Austin, TX) and his daughter, Maureen (married to Scott Fischer of Catlett, VA). Col
