AUBREY HAMILTON RICHEY, age 82, of Manassas, VA died Wednesday, April 10, 2002 at INOVA Fairfax Hospital, Falls Church, VA.

Mr. Richey was born August 3, 1919 in Nokesville, VA, the son of the late William Strater and Pearl Hamilton Davis Richey.
