December 20, 1938 - October 29, 2022

Barbara Lee Noel Crowe, a business owner and long-time resident of Manassas and Gainesville, VA, passed away on October 29th, 2022, at the age of 83 after a brief but brave battle with lung cancer. 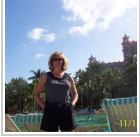
