Barbara M. Daniels, age 59, passed away on March 11, 2019 at Inova Fairfax Hospital surrounded by her loving family. She was born July 12, 1959 to Joseph and Jennie (Sciabica) McGowan of Alexandria, Virginia. Barbara married Kevin Daniels of Nokesville Virginia on the 10th of April 1999. She was a graduate of T.C. Williams High School and George Washington and George Mason Universities. She earned her Ph.D. in Education from George Mason University in 2009. In the field of education, Barbara was both a middle and high school instructor and a member of the central office "Instructional Support Team" providing curriculum support for teachers in Prince William County. She was also selected for a 2-year position as Teacher in Residence for the National Museum of the Marine Corps at Quantico Virginia. While earning her Ph.D., she worked at George Mason developing and administering a virtual High School. In her most recent educational assignment, Dr. Daniels worked at George C. Round Elementary School in the City of Manassas as a Technology Coach for staff and students. At Round, she also sponsored the "Rocky Coder/Gamer" Club for students.

Barbara also found great joy in singing. She performed informally as a "Sweet Adaline" barbershopper and in community theatre. She was a member of the "Paul Hill Chorale" for 11 years performing regionally, most notably the many performances at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C. Barbara used her talents to serve the church as both a choir member and Cantor. During the 1980's and 90's she was an often-requested

cantor in Northern Virginia and Washington D.C.

Barbara enjoyed hiking in National Parks and regional historic sites. She also enjoyed gardening and entertaining friends at home from the "Command Center" (kitchen), sharing her love through cooking. Barbara opened her home freely and loved her family and friends dearly. Barbara and Kevin purchased a home in Hartwell, GA where she had planned to retire in June. Barbara is survived by her husband Andrew Kevin Daniels; son Richard Hollinger and his wife Amanda; daughter Misty Daniels; and granddaughter Charlotte Hollinger. She is also survived by her mother Jennie McGowan; siblings Joseph (Jane) McGowan III, Mary (George) Wheeler, Sean (Patricia) McGowan, Anita (David) Klima and eight nieces and nephews.

A funeral Mass will be held at All Saints Catholic Church, 9300 Stonewall Rd., Manassas, VA 20110 at 4:30 PM on Wednesday, March 20, 2019.
