Barbara Louise Hamilton passed away in her home on Sunday, January 19, 2025, in Manassas Park, VA, surrounded by her family, at the age of 75. She was a beloved Wife, Mother, Nana and friend, cherished by everyone around her.

She was the daughter of Lawrence M. and Louise F. Higgins, and the sister of Patrick Higgins and Betty Blanchette. She absolutely adored her baby brother and spoke about him often.

Barbara graduated from Langley where she studied Business at Marymount University and worked at the Pentagon for a few years. She was co-owner of Erin's Hallmark until the early 90's, and then worked for Crestar Bank (Truist) until the early 00's. In 2001, she took an offer to run the financial side of Velasquez Contractor, Inc. out of a home office in Centreville, VA. The company grew over the next few years, and she was the Office Manager for the next 18 years until she retired in 2019. The success of the company continues to thrive today because of her hard work and dedication.

Barbara met the love of her life, Joe C Hamilton, in 1984 and they started their journey together.
