April 11, 1919 - August 23, 2008

Basil David Scruggs, age 89 of Manassas, died Saturday, August 23, 2008 at his residence.

Mr. Scruggs attended Loch Lomond Baptist Church as well as Berean Baptist Church. He was a lifetime member of the VFW, Washington, DC #284. He served in the U.S. Navy for 6 ' years during World War II. Mr. Scruggs was a member of the Senior Citizens Center in Prince William County. He retired in 1976 as an Engineer from the Federal Government after over 40 years of service.

Mr. Scruggs was preceded in death in 2000 by his wife Cora Ethel Scruggs and by two sons, John Scruggs in 1988 and Bruce Scruggs in 2001.
