On July 27th, 2020, Becky Anne Schamberger Scott, 57, of Manassas, passed away after a hard fought battle with cancer.

Becky was born to William and Betty Schamberger on March 20th, 1963, in Alexandria, VA. She graduated from T.C. Williams High School, and shortly thereafter married her high school sweetheart. Together, they raised 6 children.

Becky was a devoted and loving mother and grandmother, and was well known throughout the community for her supportive and giving nature. She worked for 12 years as the Director of Educational Ministries at Washington Street United Methodist Church, and later spent her days supporting her children in pursuit of their talents.
