



Bonnie Jean Seekford

March 22, 1955 - October 28, 2023

Bonnie Jean Seekford, 68, of Manassas, Virginia, passed away on October 28, 2023 after a brief battle with colon cancer.

Bonnie was born on March 22, 1955 to Fletcher and Amelia Musgrove in Manassas, Virginia. She graduated from Osbourn High School in 1973 and went on to obtain her cosmetology license the same year. After graduating, Bonnie went on to become a hair stylist and continued this passion for the remainder of her life.

In 1979, Bonnie met her husband, Paul, at Westgate Giant Food where he worked. Bonnie agreed to a date after many failed attempts by Paul, and their love story began. They were married on March 1, 1980 in Manassas Virginia, during one of the worst snow storms in the previous 100 years. They went on to have two children, Melissa in 1981, and Tony in 1984.

Bonnie was a proud and devoted mother and spent the next 12 years raising her children. In 1993, Bonnie returned to the workforce as a unit secretary at Prince William Hospital. As she continued to learn and grow, she transitioned into Healthcare IT at Prince William Hospital, and was instrumental in building and teaching the hospital's new electronic medical record software, Meditech. Towards the end of her career, Bonnie moved to consulting and traveled the country supporting Meditech in various hospital systems. Bonnie retired in July of 2023.

To all who knew her, Bonnie was an extraordinary woman. She always had a kind word, comforting hug, and warm cup of coffee to share with everyone.

She made friends wherever she went, and always could make a bad situation good. She enjoyed spending time at their home at Lake Anna, boating, crafting and crocheting. Her favorite activity was being an Oma to her grandchildren.

She is preceded in death by her son Paul Anthony Seekford, father Fletcher Musgrove, and mother Amelia Musgrove. She is survived by her husband Paul Seekford, daughter Melissa (Daniel) Moran, grandchildren Owen and Abigail Moran, brothers Ben (Jamie) and Andy (Jodie) Musgrove, four nieces and one nephew.
