For over 20 years, Brenda worked for Berman and Lee Orthodontics as an Orthodontic Senior Technician who helped care and treat patients. Two of Brenda's greatest attributes were her radiant smile and her ability to make people feel welcome and safe – which made her career selection a perfect choice for her patients.

Brenda and her former husband, Jerry, welcomed her first child in 2005, Camryn Brooke. Camryn was the true love of her life. Brenda loved Camryn and her puppies more than anything in the world. Most will fondly remember Brenda for her radiant smile, her beautiful brown eyes, her love for her fur
