C. CARTER BATCHELLER, of McLean, Virginia died Saturday, September 25, 2004 at Annaburg Manor in Manassas, Virginia of heart failure at the age of 92.

He retired as Vice President of Stone's Mercantile Agency; a credit reporting company later purchased by TRW (now Experian). Previous jobs held included civilian statistician for the Department of War during WWII where he worked at the Pentagon, sales representative for Fuller & d'Albert Photographic Supplies as well as Pohanka Oldsmobile. He also maintained a Real Estate license and dabbled in real estate sales and investments. He was a member of AF & AM Andrew Jackson Lodge 120.

Born April 2, 1912 in Washington, D.C., Mr. Batcheller was the son of long-time residents of Alexandria, Virginia, Coleman Carter Batcheller (Sr.) and Lucile Dolan Batcheller. Mr. Batcheller Senior was a well-known realtor and restaurateur.
