



Cecil "Kirk" Johnson

April 10, 1945 - November 5, 2025

Cecil "Kirk" Johnson, Jr., 80, of Manassas, VA and formerly of Independence, MO, passed away on November 5, 2025.

He was born April 10, 1945, in Kansas City, MO; son of the late Cecil K. Johnson, Sr. and Jessie Larkin Johnson.

He graduated from Roswell High School, Roswell, NM in 1963 and New Mexico Tech in Socorro, NM in 1968.

He married Mary Clarke Johnson on August 17, 1968, in Artesia, NM.

After living in many places with his Air Force father and mother Kirk gained an appreciation for serving one's country. After college graduation, he attended Officer Candidate School in Pensacola, FL and trained to fly the A-6 Intruder for the Navy. As the Vietnam war was ending, he began his long career as a cement chemist which took him to many plants and new cities. His longest stretch in the cement industry was 39 years in Independence, MO where he raised his two children, Larry and Anne, with his loving wife Mary. Since 2019, he and Mary have lived two doors down from Anne's family in Manassas, VA.

Kirk was a dedicated community volunteer in Independence, MO. As a proud Eagle Scout, he served countless years as a leader in Boy Scout Troop #221.

He also served for over 30 years in the Eastview Lions Club. He was a lector and Eucharistic Minister at St. Joseph the Worker Catholic Church in Independence.

He is survived by his wife Mary of 57 years; son, Larry (Katie) Johnson of Rosemount, MN; daughter, Anne (Mike) Judge of Manassas, VA; grandchildren, Samuel, Dominic, Amelia, Jane, William, Benjamin, and Henry.

A Mass of Christian burial will be held at 10:30 am on Friday, November 21 at All Saints Catholic Church, 9300 Stonewall Rd. Manassas, VA. Interment will follow at Quantico National Cemetery at 12:30 pm.

The family will receive friends from 6:00 – 9:00 pm Thursday, November 20th at Pierce Funeral Home in Manassas, where the Rosary will be recited at 7:00 pm.
