Charles Ray Black, age 73 of Gainesville, VA passed away on June 14, 2020 at his residence. He was born on September 11, 1946 in McDunn, WV son of the late James and Mildred Black. He graduated from Montgomery High School. Upon graduation he was employed with Ironworkers Local Union 201 in Washington, DC as a Rodman. He achieved the position of Superintendent installing post tensioning cables in bridges and high rise buildings and traveled extensively throughout his career. He retired from VSL Corporation in 2008. He was an avid golfer and a member of the Elks Golf and County Club in Lewisburg, WV. He was a Elks Member of Lodge 1758 and received the Elk of the Year award in 2014. He also served in the U. S. Army in Vietnam from 1968-1970 with an honorable discharge. He was awarded 2 Purple Hearts, 2 Bronze Stars and numerous other medals for his acts of bravery while serving in Vietnam.

He is survived by his loving wife Rebecca of 47 years; son Derek Black and daughter Alicia Nalls; daughter-in-law Jill Black and son-in-law Lynn Nalls; brother James Black and sister in law Pat Black of Florida; sister Betty Karst of Columbia, SC; sister Charlotte Cordle of Rutledge, TN; Kenneth Black and sister-in-law Debbie Black of Dallas, TX; brother Alvin Black and sister-in-law Carol Black of Aiken, SC; his grandson Lance and his three granddaughters Sydney, Emmalise, Natalie and many nieces and nephews.
