Charles Eric Freeberg (aka Skip and/or Ricky), 60, of Manassas, Virginia died in his sleep on Sunday, September 29, 2024.

Skip, the youngest of four children, was born in Dover, Delaware in 1964 to Robert C. and Denise A. Freeberg. In his youth, the family moved to Woodbridge, Virginia, where he grew up and graduated from Woodbridge Senior High School. He went on to attend and graduate from Longwood University (then College) before beginning a long career in the banking/finance world dealing primarily with dealer finance and automobile lending. Throughout his life, Skip remained an avid sports fan, particularly of baseball and football (Dallas Cowboys & Penn State). He was a dedicated father, sibling, nephew, cousin, fraternity brother, friend, and supporter of the men and women who proudly serve our country. Many of his final days were spent attending baseball practice, tournaments, and related social events for his youngest son's baseball team. He truly loved watching Andrew play one of the greatest American past times and was proud of the work that Andrew put in both on and off the field.

Skip was preceded in death by his parents, Robert and Denise Freeberg, and his brother George Freeberg. He is survived by his 2 adult children Sam and Rachel Freeberg (Kathy Freeberg), his youngest son Andrew Freeberg (LaRee Pallone), his granddaughter Melanie (Sam), his sisters Catherine Odum and Chris McBride, and several nieces and nephews.

There will be a Catholic funeral mass on Monday, December 2, 2024. Services will begin at 1:00 pm at All Saints Catholic Church located at 9300 Stonewall Rd, Manassas, VA 20110. Interment will follow the Mass at Place of Peace Columbarium located at 9535 Linton Hall Rd, Bristow, VA 20136. All are welcome to attend and pay their final respects.
