Charles Hayden Reedy, Jr. age 82, passed away on Sunday, December 3, 2017 at the Adler Center for Caring in Aldie, Virginia.

He was born on April 14, 1935 in Groseclose, Virginia to the late Charles Hayden Reedy, Sr. and Ola Alice (Arney) Reedy. Mr. Reedy received his undergraduate from East Tennessee State University and his Masters Degree from Virginia Tech. He was a U.S. Army Veteran and a member of the VFW 7589 Francis Cannon Post. 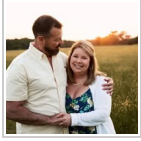

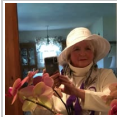
