Charles Stanley Tippett of Broad Run, Virginia passed away on August 11, 2023. He was born in Washington, DC on August 12, 1933, to Joseph Latimer Tippett and Josephine Victoria Goode Tippett. Charlie was one of 13 siblings and a twin.

Charlie was honorably discharged from the United States Navy. He worked for the Air Force Association and retired after more than 40 years.
