Charles Davis Weir, known as Dave by all, passed from this life peacefully on Wednesday, November 30, 2022, surrounded by family. Dave was 68 years young.

Dave was born on February 15, 1954, to Lynn Davis Weir and John Gordon Weir in Munich Germany, where his father was stationed as a Lieutenant Colonel in the Air Force. Dave's father's military service provided him the opportunity to travel throughout his childhood, attending more than 15 different schools to finally complete high school in Fairfax VA. Dave joined the Navy and began active duty on January 10, 1977, serving Fighter Squadron SEVENTY-FOUR, stationed at NAS Oceana, Virginia Beach VA. Dave often recounted his time in service as having been the "time of his life".

Dave was an avid motorcyclist, a biker through and through. Dave's road name was "Gadget" and fitting it was as it described his love of gadgets. Dave couldn't pass up purchasing the latest and greatest tools to make his life easier. He thoroughly enjoyed his brotherhood with several motorcycle clubs over the years and one near to his heart was that of former military servicemen and officers, Old Dogs Veterans Motorcycle Association, with whom he traveled yearly. Dave is dearly missed among the motorcycle club community.

When Dave wasn't riding his Harley, he was driving for Lyft. He also thoroughly enjoyed this role during which he met people traveling to and moving around the Northern Virginia area. He prided himself on his 5-star rating and always had a story to share with family after a day of driving. Dave also enjoyed spending time with his family, and that was easy since his children and grandchildren were home, living with him.

Dave is survived by his wife, Michele Weir, two children, daughter Katherine Weir and son Bailey Weir, two grandchildren Abigail and Ethan Roberts, sister Beverly Gilbert and her husband Curt Gilbert, brother John "Butch" Weir, nieces, nephews, and cousins. He is preceded in death by his first child Cristina Weir.

A viewing will be held at Pierce Funeral Home in Manassas on Saturday December 10, 2022, from 4-5 pm and a service will follow at 5 pm. Dave will have a military interment at Arlington National Cemetery at a later date.
