Christian Thomas Spicer Jr, 19, passed away peacefully at his home in Bristow, Virginia, on March 11, 2026.

Christian was born on April 21, 2006, in Fairfax, Virginia. He was the oldest of three brothers, and his younger siblings always looked up to him as a role model. Christian was homeschooled in his early years before later attending Seton School in Manassas, Virginia.

Christian was a genuinely kind and gentle young man who consistently went out of his way to help others. His Catholic faith was the center of his life, and he loved Jesus deeply. Christian had a sincere desire to share his faith with others, and on several occasions, people credited him with helping guide them into the Catholic Church.

Christian was accepted to Belmont Abbey College and had planned to begin his studies in August 2024. He hoped to study theology and one day become a Catholic priest.

Around that same time, Christian became critically ill and was ultimately unable to begin college. Throughout his long illness, he continued to demonstrate quiet strength, faith, and trust in our Lord's plan for his life.

Though his life was far too short, Christian will be remembered for his gentle spirit, his deep faith, and the compassion he showed to others.
