“ I met Clara and her amazing family shortly after getting married and moving to Adak, Alaska. Clara was my first military spouse friend. Believe it or not, she worked for my husband, Dean, on the public works side (Dean would say it was more the other way around that he worked for her) and I worked for Jim on the construction side in the ROICC office.

Our paths crossed many times during our husbands' careers and even when we were not stationed near each other we spoke at length on the phone. Over the years when I would call, sometimes I would forget what coast we were all on and would wake Clara and Jim late at night. Upon those occasions Clara still would always chat with me.

When Jackie was young, and the family was stationed in Monterey, we all went to Disneyland where I purchased a Thumper stuffed animal. Jackie had me zip him up in our backpack with his head out so he would be able to see all that we were doing and be able to breath. I still have that Thumper stuffed animal and the memories flood back when I see him.

My family moved to Manassas when Clara, Jim, and kiddos were living in the house on Greeley Blvd. We saw a lot of each other during those five years. Anyone who met Clara would find out quickly that Clara loved estate sales. Clara was always on the hunt for a good deal. I lost count of how many estate sales we attended during those years.

Clara was a kind soul, with an infectious laugh and was always there to get you through a rough spot with grace and guidance. Clara helped make me a better wife, mother, friend, and human over the years.

I spoke with Clara a few days before she passed. We laughed and giggled over our shared memories during that call. I even heard Jim in the background yelling, "Is that Corie?" Clara responded, with that dry joking tone, that yes, it was Corie and we spoke until she was tired and needed to take a break.

I will miss her kindness, love, and friendship every day. My heart and love go out to her family and friends during this time of sorrow.

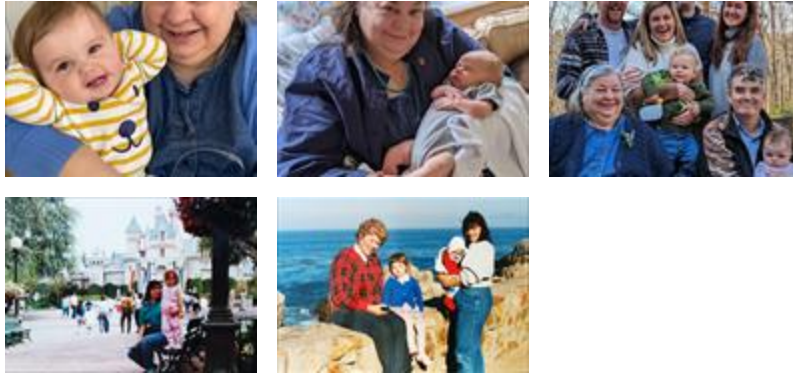
