



## Clyde Daniel Wimmer

December 11, 1937 - May 22, 2025

Clyde Daniel Wimmer, loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, and friend, passed away peacefully on Thursday, May 22, 2025. He was 87.

A true country boy, Clyde was born and raised in Saltville, VA, where he grew up on his parent's and grandparent's farms. As a young man, he became an electronics specialist for Melpar, then moved to Prince William County to become a fire marshal. He is best known, however, for his role as Director of Public Works for the City of Manassas for over 25 years. Clyde was also active in both the Yorkshire and Manassas Volunteer Fire Companies. He rose to the position of Chief and was the first certified instructor for fire fighter training in Prince William County. Clyde maintained friendships with many coworkers, even in his long and distinguished retirement.

He is survived by his loving wife of forty years, Nancy; his daughter, Helen Krueger and her husband, Ronald; his grandchildren: William (Billy) Krueger and his wife Renee, Luke Krueger and his wife Stephanie, and Samuel Krueger; and his two great-grandsons: Connor and Colby. He is also survived by his brother, Kyle Wimmer, Kyle's wife Faye, and many other family and friends.
