



Curtis "Curt" William Wunderly

April 14, 1945 - May 6, 2017

Surrounded by his loving wife and three daughters, Curtis "Curt" William Wunderly, age 72, of Manassas, Virginia passed away on Saturday, May 6, 2017.

He was born on April 14, 1945 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, the son of the late John and Dolores (Moul) Wunderly. He was a member of All Saints Catholic Church in Manassas, VFW Post 10 in Manassas, and served as a Captain in the United States Army. He was a veteran of the Vietnam War, leaving for the war only three weeks after he was married. He received his undergraduate degree in Education from Duquesne University, and received a Masters in Public Administration from George Mason University.

Curt was actively involved in Manassas City schools and was a founding member of the 2 A Booster Club at Osbourn High School, where he served as the president for six years. He also served his community for 16 years as a member of the Manassas City School Board. Curt worked for the Federal Government for 30 years, ending his career as a Network Engineer for the Department of Defense. His home was where the family gathered regularly and he was happiest when surrounded by his children and grandchildren.

Survivors include his wife of 48 years, Joanne E. Wunderly; three daughters, Kristin Forman, Julie Brann, and Beth Wunderly; three brothers, John

Wunderly, James Wunderly, and Mark Wunderly; sons-in-law, Steven Forman, Shawn Brann, and David Mason; six grandchildren, Curtis Forman, Aaron Forman, Sophia Brann, Tyler Brann, Emma Mason, and Zoe Mason; and mother-in-law, Edith Botti.

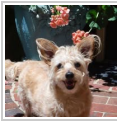
