Daniel Joseph Lucckese, 43, of Manassas, VA, died on December 7, 2025, at Mary Washington Hospital. He was born on August 10, 1982, to Deborah and David Lucckese.

Dan was a talented guitarist and singer, and music played a central and enduring role in his life. He graduated in 2005 from Shenandoah University with a bachelor's degree in Business Administration. Through his entrepreneurial spirit, he founded and maintained a successful government sales business for many years.

Dan served on the board of his family's legacy organization, the Washington Forrest Foundation, which has provided funding to many nonprofit organizations in Louisa, including Louisa United Methodist Church, the Louisa K.S. Club, the Louisa County 4-H Livestock Club, and Giving Words.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Deborah Lucckese; his paternal grandparents, Natale and Eloise Lucckese; and his maternal grandparents, Frank and Charlotte Gravett.
