



Daniel Anthony Rogers

February 5, 1945 - January 10, 2025

Daniel (Dan) Anthony Rogers of Haymarket, VA, went to meet our Lord Jesus on January 10, 2025. Dan was born on February 5, 1945, in Erie, PA, which is also where he met the love of his life. With his passing, Dan has now regained all his memories, lost his physical and emotional pain, and joined his beloved wife Eve Janet (Morettini) Rogers in Heaven.

Dan worked for AT&T Communications for more than 30 years, many of them in Pittsburgh, PA, allowing Eve to stay home and raise their four children. Late in his career, Dan moved to Bell Laboratories, a huge honor as employment at Bell Laboratories required a Master's Degree in science or math, and Dan only had a High School Diploma. Dan was a Founding Member of St. Katharine Drexel Mission since September 2000 and was an active member of the mission for the rest of his life. Dan became a Charter Resident at Capitol Ridge in Bristow, VA after being diagnosed with Alzheimer's, and was a friend to every resident while there. Dan's joyous and outgoing personality led him to speak to everyone he encountered. He lived with prostate cancer for almost a year before the Lord rescued him from its pain.

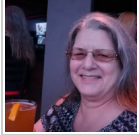
