



## Darryl Keith Daudet

September 9, 1935 - November 8, 2021

Darryl K. Daudet, 86, passed away Monday November 8, 2021, at his daughter's home in Middletown, MD. Darryl was born in Scottdale, PA and grew up in his hometown of McDonald, PA where he graduated from McDonald High.

Darryl served in the US Marines and graduated from an engineering trade school before leaving Pennsylvania and settling in the Northern Virginia area with his wife and 3 children. He worked in various engineering firms over the years as a programmer on many government projects until his retirement at the age of 68. He was also an avid member of the Knights of Columbus in Manassas, VA serving in many positions over the years where he made many lifelong friends along the way.
