David R. Wiser of Manassas, VA died Wednesday, January 11, 2023 in a local hospital.

A son of the late Mr. & Mrs. Lloyd Wiser, he was born September 29, 1937 in East Alton, IL He and his wife moved to Virginia after accepting new employment in 1965.

Dave served three years in the U.S. Army, graduated from Southern Illinois University, and was hired by the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency in Washington D.C. soon after. He completed his career with the Drug Enforcement Administration as an Assistant Special Agent in Charge. He was retired for nearly 35 years.

The only survivor is his wife, the former Carol Green, whom he married March 14, 1959 in East Alton. Three Brothers & two Sisters predeceased him.

“ Dave was one of the very few agents in the Washington DO when I arrived from the NYDO in September of 1968. One indelible memory from our time together at the WDO was in 1969 when we worked the midnight shift together on that historic night when the astronauts first landed on the moon. In the 70's we both ended up in the Office of Inspection, he in Miami and me in DC, and we did a memorable tour through South America. Highlight of the trip was that night in the hotel bar in São Paulo when we became convinced we were sitting next to Josef Mengele, the infamous Nazi war criminal. The fact that it was later determined that the fugitive had lived in São Paulo for years before dying there in 1979 convinced us that we might have been right. Just about every time Dave and I got together over the years we would trade trivial pursuit questions and discuss old movies and TV shows. Lots of great memories. Rest in Peace, my friend.
