Debra Michelle Webb Eddins, 49, of Stafford, Virginia, went home to be with Jesus on Tuesday, July 19, 2016. Debbie was preceded in death by her father Charles Webb, her paternal grandparents Sterling and Mabel Webb, and her maternal grandparents Roscoe and Lyla Croushorn. She is survived by her husband of 27 years Tony Eddins; her three sons Andrew, Austin, and Justin Eddins; her mother Margaret Webb; her father-in-law and mother-in-law Michael and Shirley Swan; and her sisters and their families Dawn Blevins (Barry), Dena Warren (David), and Dori Donley (Anthony). She is also survived by several uncles, aunts, and cousins.
