Delgie Lorenzo Jones Sr. was born on October 30th, 1960 in Beaumont, Texas and the son of Florine (Cluff) Jones and Odell Jones. He is the eldest child of 4 and grew up in Tucson, Arizona. He attended Sunny Side High School where he played football and excelled at music.

Delgie was baptized and became a member of Grace Temple missionary Baptist Church in Tucson at an early age. Music became his passion, and he cultivated his musical skills through different positions at churches through the United States.

After graduating high school, he attended the University of Arizona and later married Yolanda Wilson in 1981, and embarked on a career in the Air Force. From that union, two children were born - Delgie Lorenzo II and Airicka Michelle. On the foundation of his Air Force tenure, Delgie built a career in Aerospace; obtaining his Bachelor's and MBA from the University of Phoenix. Delgie also attended several elite executive training programs at Wharton School of Business (University of Pennsylvania) and Kellogg School of Business (Northwestern University). His success propelled him to the executive-level as Vice President of Security & Intelligence with BAE Systems.

In his free-time, Delgie committed himself to spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ. Delgie occupied many positions with the church including Minister of

Music, ordained Deacon, ordained Minister, Virginia State Men's Leader of Full Gospel. Delgie loved his family immensely, including his 11 grandchildren (Airiell, Jackson, Adriel, Matthew, Khrissy, Maddison, Khinley, Neil, Irvin, Karsyn, and Jordyn).

Delgie is survived by his Mother, Florine C Jones, one sister, Dansiea Morris (Leon) of Arizona; son, Delgie Jones II (Kiera) of Colorado, one daughter Airicka Pearson (Maryland), his former wife Yolanda Wilson (Texas), nephew, Leon Jr, and 9 of his grandchildren; aunts, uncles, and a host of relatives and friends.
