DONALD D. FLETCHER, a long time resident of Manassas, Virginia died Sunday, August 6, 2006 at Prince William Hospital, Manassas.

Mr. Fletcher was born July 6, 1925 in Buchanan County, Virginia, the second son of Roby and Grace Fletcher. He served aboard the battleship USS Wisconsin as a plank member during World War II and received five battle stars and numerous citations. He retired from Fruit Growers Express Company in 1985 after 38 years of dedicated service to the railroad. He spent much of his retirement enjoying his favorite pastime of gardening and providing fresh produce to family and friends.
