



## Dorothy Ann Fontain

January 9, 1989 - April 5, 2023

Dorothy Ann (D'Ann) Horton, lovingly referred to as "Joey" by her family, died April 5, 2023—coincidentally, her mother's birth date—in a horrific car accident that also took the life of her 5-year old daughter, Empress Madine-Johanna Fontain. Born on June 9, 1989, in Los Angeles, California to Dorothy Ann Stevenson and Curtis Wyatt Horton, D'Ann was a resident of Woodbridge, Virginia at the time of her death. D'Ann loved her job at CVS Health, where she felt she was making a difference in other people's lives. She, in turn, was beloved by her co-workers. Like her daughter, Empress, D'Ann loved to sing and dance. They both loved art and D'Ann was passionate about photography. Empress, a kindergartener at Mary Williams Elementary School in Prince William County, was outgoing and impressed all who knew her with her larger-than-life personality. D'Ann is survived by five of her children (Empress's siblings), Ava Ann Clapp, Kiley Shea Clapp, Javan Elias Horton, Emajen Divine Fontain and Pharaoh Omari Fontain; her siblings (Empress's uncle and aunts), Derek Richard Cicheskie, Ariel May Wray, Tanya Marquess and Shelley; her loving nieces and nephews (Empress's cousins); her uncles (Empress's great-uncles), Earl Stevenson and Conrad Pretorious; and her father, Curtis Wyatt Horton. D'Ann is preceded in death by her mother, Dorothy Ann Stevenson, (May 22, 2019); her uncle, Jonathan Stevenson; her grandmother, Dorothy May Stevenson (April 6, 2021) and her beloved dog, Pirate.
