



Douglas Henry Boyett M.D.

August 17, 1963 - June 24, 2023

Dr. Douglas Henry Boyett, M.D., passed away peacefully at his home in Manassas, Virginia on Saturday June 24th, 2023. He was 59 years old. Dr. Boyett is survived in death by his wife Rhonda Kelley Boyett, daughter Elizabeth Grace Boyett, father Col. Joseph Edward Boyett Jr., USAF, retired, brother Maj. Joseph Edward Boyett III, USA, retired, sister Joy Denise Boyett Miller and brother-in-law David Miller, nephew's Jacob Edward Miller and Andrew David Miller, niece Heather Elizabeth Boyett Brookshire, (Thomas Brookshire), great niece Julia Frost Brookshire and great nephew Jackson Henry Brookshire. He was preceded in death by his mother Faye Joyce Stone Boyett. Dr. Boyett graduated from the University of Alabama with a medical degree and completed his residency in family practice by 1992. He was board certified in both family medicine and emergency medicine but spent his entire career specializing in emergency medicine and working in emergency rooms caring for patients and comforting families in some of the most trying times of their lives. Doug was well respected by patients, families, and colleagues. His coworkers would call him at home and ask if he would come in to see their loves that were sick. He met his wife in an Alabama emergency room over 31 years ago, she was a nurse in the same department. They continued to work together until he retired from emergency medicine in 2015. They adopted their only daughter in 2003, which brought him joy beyond measure. Doug enjoyed family, friends, and he loved to travel, exploring foreign places visiting all the continents except Antarctica; most recently spending time in Africa and

cruising through the Panama Canal with his family. He will be missed dearly by all.
