It is with profound sadness that we announce the passing of E. Marie Liller on April 2, 2025, at the age of 80, after a long battle with cancer. Beloved daughter, sister, wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother, her life was characterized by dedication to and love for her family and church. She was born in a small rural setting in the Shenandoah Valley of Virginia on July 2, 1944. After graduating from high school, Marie joined the Navy and was an Air Traffic controller during her tour of duty. There she met her husband, William Liller and they married on July 10, 1964.
