Elsie Lee Shrewsbury (Bishop), 96, passed away peacefully on February 13, 2025, in Bealeton, Virginia. Born on August 18, 1928, in Red Ash, Virginia, Elsie lived a life centered around faith, family, and service to others.

On April 22, 1950, Elsie married Ted Shrewsbury, and together they built a loving home in Nokesville, Virginia, where they raised their four children. Their marriage was a testament to devotion until Ted's passing on May 24, 2006.
