



Eunice Marie Ebhardt Olive

September 19, 1935 - February 29, 2016

Eunice Marie Ebhardt Olive was born in Prince William County at the Historic Landmark, The Henry House on September 19, 1935. Eunice passed away on Monday, February 29, 2016 after a long valiant battle with cancer since 2012.

She was the daughter of the late Raymond M. and Ressie (nee Scarborough) Edhardt. She was educated in the elementary and secondary schools in Prince William County and was a 1954 graduate of Osbourn High School and pursued a career in nursing which lasted approximately 35 years.

She is survived by her husband of 60 years, Chester R. Olive; her three children, Chester R. Olive, Jr and wife Lynne of Palmyra, VA, Donna Raye Vecchio of Cockeysville, MD and Frederick M. Olive and wife Kimberly of Myrtle Beach, SC. Also surviving is a sister Raedelle E. Reeves of Manassas, VA and 8 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren.

She was a member of the Grace & Glory Lutheran Church in Palmyra, VA and a prior member of the Oakdale Baptist Church in Nokesville, VA.
