



## Florence Callahan Fisher

December 30, 1918 - April 12, 2013

Florence Edna Callahan Fisher, 94, a devoted mother, grandmother, homemaker and member of Grace United Methodist Church, died April 12, 2013 surrounded by her loving family after complications of a stroke.
