PASTOR FLOYD ISAAC BAKER, 81, of Martinsburg, West Virginia passed away Wednesday, February 18, 2015 at the Winchester Medical Center.

He was born on January 24, 1934 in Haymarket, Virginia the son of the late William A and Ollie S. (Judd) Baker. He served as pastor for the Camp Springs Community Church in Camp Springs, Maryland for over 23 years.
