FLOYD D. "SHORTY" VETTER, SR., age 95 of Manassas, Virginia died Friday, April 10, 2009 at Caton Merchant House in Manassas.

Mr. Vetter was a lifetime resident of Manassas. He was a member of Grace United Methodist Church. Mr. Vetter worked 46 years with the local phone company which is now Verizon. He was a lifetime member of the Manassas Volunteer Fire Department, serving as Chief from 1956 to 1959.
