



## Gary Flatt

August 15, 1943 - March 25, 2004

Gary Allen Flatt, age 60 of Manassas, died Thursday, March 25, 2004 at Prince William Hospital.

An avid NASCAR fan, his interest included football, golfing and hunting. He painted the best appearing Sportsman (Bush) car in the 70's. He customized a 1940 Ford street rod that appeared in several magazines and was put in the first collectable baseball style cards for street rods. He started his career at Eustace-Frost Ford, where he served his apprenticeship, then to Ted Britt Ford and Jim McKay Chevrolet before becoming a salesman at BASF where at the end of his career, he was in the top 14 salesmen for BASF.
