



## George Lindly

May 12, 1917 - October 12, 2012

GEORGE RANDOLPH LINDLY, age 95, died Friday, Oct. 12, 2012 at Prince William Hospital, Manassas, VA. Born May 12, 1917 in Bynum, TX, Randolph was the son of George Calvin and Mary Ellen (Hicks) Lindly. He is predeceased by his parents, his wife Alta Mae (Simpson) Lindly, two brothers, and three sisters. Survivors include his sister Willie Ruth Thompson of Odessa, TX; children Linda Smith (husband Thomas) of Manassas VA and Cynthia Seery of Annapolis MD; grandchildren Amy Robertson, Ryan Smith, Jennifer Seery, and Katherine Seery; and five great-grandchildren.

Randolph served in the Navy during WWII as a radioman on the USS Saratoga where he also flew as a crewman on Dauntless dive-bombers. After leaving the Navy in 1946 he returned to farming in Texas and eventually moved to Arizona where he worked for the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation as a Hydrologist. He retired there in 1962 and in 2000 he and Alta moved to Manassas to live with his daughter and her husband. In August 2011 he moved to Sudley Manor House in Manassas.
