George Cody Sheflett, Jr., 53, of Charles Town, West Virginia, suddenly passed away on Tuesday, January 16, 2024 with his wife, Robin Sheflett (née Gagnon) lovingly by his side. His loss is unexpected, and his family is profoundly saddened.

Cody is survived by his wife Robin, their two children Madison and Carter, his parents George and Sharon, his brother Chris and his wife, and numerous aunts, uncles, cousins, and nieces and nephews.
