



## Gertrude Muddiman

September 22, 1924 - October 29, 2020

Gertrude Muddiman, 96, made her heavenly journey Wednesday, October 28, 2020, from her home in Manassas, VA. A daughter of the late John Bryan and Mary Belle (McGlothlin) Childress, Gertrude was born September 22, 1924, in Buchanan County. She moved with family to Prince William County in 1941.

A long-time minister, she founded Yorkshire Full Gospel in 1969 and served as its pastor for 34 years. Her devotion to her Lord and Savior showed in her daily walk—in her prayer life and Bible study, in her desire to bring souls into God's kingdom, and in her care for those both nearby and in mission fields afar. She was a pioneer for other women in the ministry.

Survivors include her husband of 74 years James B. Muddiman, daughter Beverly June Muddiman (Bob) of Hayward, CA, and son James Roger Muddiman of the home, along with grandchildren Charles Denis Harris, Robert Gallegos Jr, Yvonne Gallegos, Karen Gallegos, Janell Sarmento, and Wesley Gallegos, 20 great grandchildren and 20 great great grandchildren. Other survivors include her siblings: Robert E. Childress (Lorane) of Front Royal, Donald R. Childress (Joyce) of Sebring, FL, Zed L. Childress (Rebekah) of Gainesville, and Madilee C. Wnek of Manassas, along with many nieces and nephews.

Gertrude's daughter Judith Betty Harris pre-deceased her, as did her brothers Reves, Benson, and John Childress, and her sisters Arbutus Childress,

Fayrene Clayborn, Joan Sue Childress, and Dian Blair.

Rev. Tommy Lindsey, pastor of Soul's Harbor Church of God, will conduct the funeral service, with assistance from Rev. Joe Addison, at Pierce Funeral Home, 9609 Center Street, Manassas. Two viewings are scheduled for Wednesday, Nov. 4: 2-4 p.m. and 7-9 p.m. Only 50 people will be allowed in at one time. The funeral is scheduled for Thursday, Nov. 5, 10:30 a.m., and only 70 people will be allowed into this service. A graveside service will follow the funeral from Noon to 12:30 p.m. at Stonewall Memory Gardens, 12004 Lee Highway, Manassas. For the viewings, funeral, and graveside service, the funeral home is requiring masks and encouraging social distancing.
